

1,000 USD PER YEAR

THE IMPACT OF YOUR INVESTMENT

Provides professional training for 6 adults in difficult situations (confronted with either abuse, poverty or disability) to help them find a job and become financially independent.

Provides minimum housing conditions for 4 families living in extreme poverty (in many cases, living on the streets).

Enables 3 children to stay in school: support with their homework and learning new skills, while their basic needs are met: one hot meal a day, school supplies, and clothing for going to school.

10,000 USD PER YEAR

Helps 18 elderly people without any family left, confined to bed and with very small income (less than 100 euro per month), and/or suffering from serious illnesses to receive full social and medical homecare services.

Support with scholarships 22 gifted children with outstanding academic results, coming from underprivileged families, to finish high-school and access higher education.

Provides rehabilitation for 11 homeless people, from living on the street to a normal life (includes obtaining legal documents, medical health costs, accessing legal rights, shelter, psychological and legal counseling, professional training and employment.)

Partnering with United Way Romania is a demonstration of one's willingness to set an example, to inspire others to help ease suffering and to offer hope that will brighten tomorrow for all of us. Behind each contribution is a very personal, powerful commitment to human needs



United Way's Leadership Givers

Leadership giving membership and recognition is granted to individuals who contribute annually with 1,000 USD or more to the United Way cause.

United Way Alexis de Tocqueville Society

The Tocqueville Society helps celebrate and deepen relationships between United Way and community leaders. The name of this society was chosen because of Alexis de Tocqueville's admiration for the American spirit of volunteerism and effort for the community good.

Membership is granted to individuals who contribute annually to United Way from \$10,000 to \$1 million. Worldwide there are nearly 500 Million Dollar Roundtable members, and more than 25,000 Society members.

The Society is an international network of leaders that fosters and recognizes exceptional levels of personal giving and community service.

COMMUNITY PROBLEMS AND UNITED WAY SOLUTIONS

With the support from our donors, we are helping to improve communities and lives in measurable and lasting ways by focusing on the building blocks for a good quality of life: Education, Income and Health.

THE PROBLEMS

JCATION

17% of children enrolled in 1st grade drop out of school by the end of the 8th grade. Every year, almost 30,000 children drop out of school.

10,000 children with serious illnesses are hospitalized every year, for long periods of time, with no access to education.

ALTH

Of the 1,3 million elderly citizens over 75, more than 50% live alone.

Every year, in Romania, over 40,000 people die of cancer and 49,000 new cases are being diagnosed.

Of the 15,000 homeless people in Romania, approximately 5,000 live in Bucharest.

One in every three women in Romania suffers at least one form of domestic violence (physical, sexual, psychological) from a male family member. Out of every 1,000 women that give birth every year, 43 are less than 18 years old.

OUR SOLUTIONS

UCATIO

We invest in daycare centers where children coming from underprivileged families do their homework and receive school supplies, clothing and a hot meal.

We offer educational and artistic activities, clinical animation programs, origami, theater, painting, to help them fight with their illness and remain strong during the time they spent in hospital, most of the time alone, without their parents;

EALT

We invest in homecare services, medical and social services for elderly people at risk – confined to bed, with small income (less than 100 euro/month) or suffering from serious illnesses.

We support palliative care centers for people suffering from terminal illnesses and offer social and psychological services for their families/caregivers.

COME

We support intervention and recovery centers that help homeless people find a job / access their legal rights and rebuild their lives.

We invest in care centers for victims of abuse and shelters for young mothers and their children, to avoid maternal abandonment and support them . They receive housing, legal and psychological counseling; they also learn to find a job and be financially independent.
