REFLECTIONS ON ALEXIS DE TOCQUEVILLE



Only 26 years old when he came to America in 1831, Alexis Charles-Henri de Tocqueville traveled all over the United States and his observations formed the basis of his book "Democracy in America", a study of American society and politics. One of his most important observations was that Americans hold in common a unique willingness to work for the public welfare - a tendency for voluntary action on behalf of the common good. The observation on philanthropy made by Alexis de Tocqueville in 1831 is true today; advancing the common good means creating opportunities for a better life for all. In this spirit, United Way created The Alexis de Tocqueville Society in 1984. Today, the Society provides members the opportunity to be part of a movement that is dedicated to improving lives through philanthropic leadership by focusing on the building blocks for a better life: a quality education that leads to a stable job; income that can support a family, and good health, which in turn will lead to a stronger community.

Each of their contribution supports numerous children from underprivileged families, elderly people and adults to overcome their problems and transition to a normal life. At **European level**, the United Way Tocqueville Society has the largest number of members in France, where it is presided by Jean-Guillaume de Tocqueville d'Hérouville, Alexis de Tocqueville's descendant and a champion of philanthropy himself. He advocates volunteering and donating his time and energy to United Way across Europe, to business people and nobility who can get involved in their communities and help them thrive.

Worldwide, the Society founded more than 25 years ago in order to deepen the understanding, commitment, and support of United Way's most generous investors, to recognize and honor those concerned individuals who accepted a leadership role in making major financial contributions to United Way, now gathers over 25,000 members all over the world.
